

R. AGUIRRE, C. BERNABÉ, AND C. GIL, *Qué se sabe de... Jesús de Nazaret* (Estella [Navarra]: Verbo Divino, 2009, paper €15) 271 pp. Bibliography. ISBN: 978-84-8169-922-7.

After Gil's seven-page introduction, this volume presents Bernabé's essay on the quest of the historical Jesus—the history of the investigation and its importance. Next there are chapters by Gil on the context of Jesus' life and on his origins, Aguirre on the birth of Jesus, Gil on the actions of Jesus, Bernabé on the relations of Jesus with other persons and groups, Aguirre on Jesus' religious experience, Bernabé on Jesus' final conflict, and Aguirre on who Jesus is. Then with regard to open questions in the current debate, Bernabé discusses the origin of Easter faith. Finally all three (who are professors of NT at the University of Deusto) reflect on the present relevance of the history of Jesus, and Aguirre and Gil provide an annotated bibliography about the historical Jesus.
