

THE PROPHETS

2202. [Prophets] FRANCES RAMIS DARDER, *Los Profetas* (Qué se sabe de . . . 4; Estella [Navarra]: EDV, 2010). Pp. 263. Paper N.P. ISBN 978-84-9945-134-3.

In this small volume, R. provides Spanish-language readers with a basic orientation to the prophets of the OT and their books. The volume comprises four parts. First, R. addresses the question of who a prophet is—in both biblical and contemporary times—and surveys the study of the prophetic phenomenon. Next, he provides brief accounts of the lives, times and messages of the writing prophets. Thereafter, he treats in turn the political involvement of (selected) pre-writing prophets, the marital history of Hosea and its metaphorical significance, and the persons and activities of the OT prophetesses. Finally, he presents summary reflections on the contemporary relevance of biblical prophecy, here highlighting the prophets' common passion for a more just world and the varying forms this took, given the different situations they faced. The volume concludes with a short, annotated bibliography of (Spanish-language) materials for further study of biblical prophecy.
